Leading Church into Growth (LyCiG) training

ast Sunday, I announced the most recent online LyCiG Refresh training that I attended (together with one other parish councillor). Understanding LyCiG principles is essential to better engage in the process. The topic discussed was, "Creating a Prayerful Culture of Growth" at St. John's. Some ideas to further encourage and enhance a culture of praying for growth were:

- Unpacking the theology of the LyCiG prayer.
- Incorporating creative actions while praying the LyCiG.
- Praying with creative actions could continue during the usual intercessory prayer time.
- Praying intentionally for five people known to us.
- Praying with a sense of expectancy.
- Prayerfully identifying areas where there is minimal representation in the church services and then going for a prayer walk in those areas.

We also spoke about challenges which hinder growing a prayerful culture of growth. In the group I was in, we identified elements like hardness of the heart and the existing culture that is unwilling to change.

We also spoke of 'stepping stone' events that could be used to invite people back to church. Some suggestions included inviting people for special services, Craft Group, Messy Church and Messy Movies. Inviting people to special services, Craft Group and Messy Church are already happening at St. John's. Messy Movies refers to the screening of family-oriented movies in the church with popcorn and light supper provided. For this to occur, a license for screening movies publicly is required.

I look forward to the next LyCiG Refresh session on 6 June (7.30pm to 8.30pm). Why not join me and participate in this session from the comfort of your own home? I pray that many parishioners will be willing to join in and participate. The focus is "Beginning a Planned Journey of Growth." Santa, Soli Deo Gloria ©
